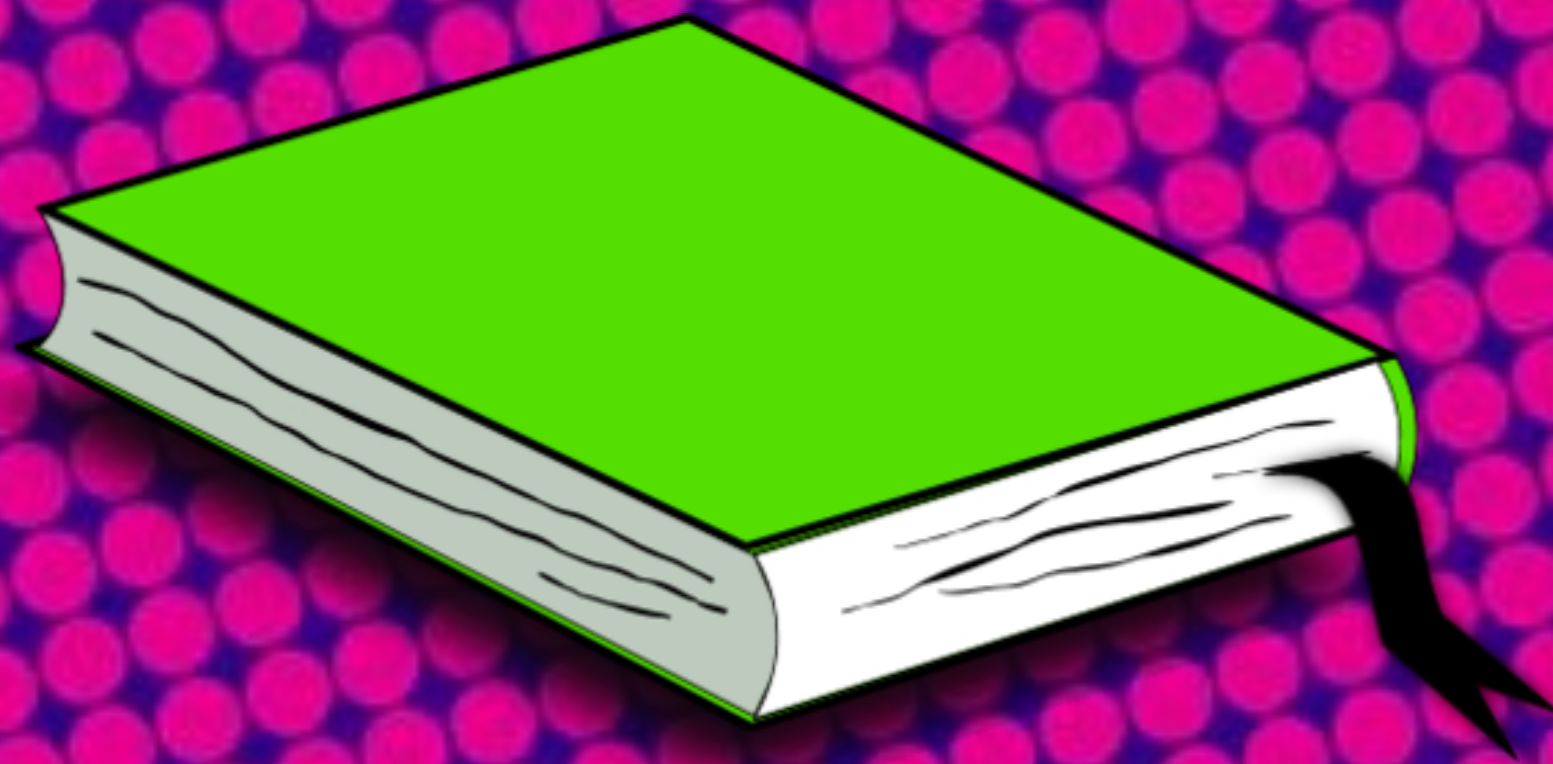


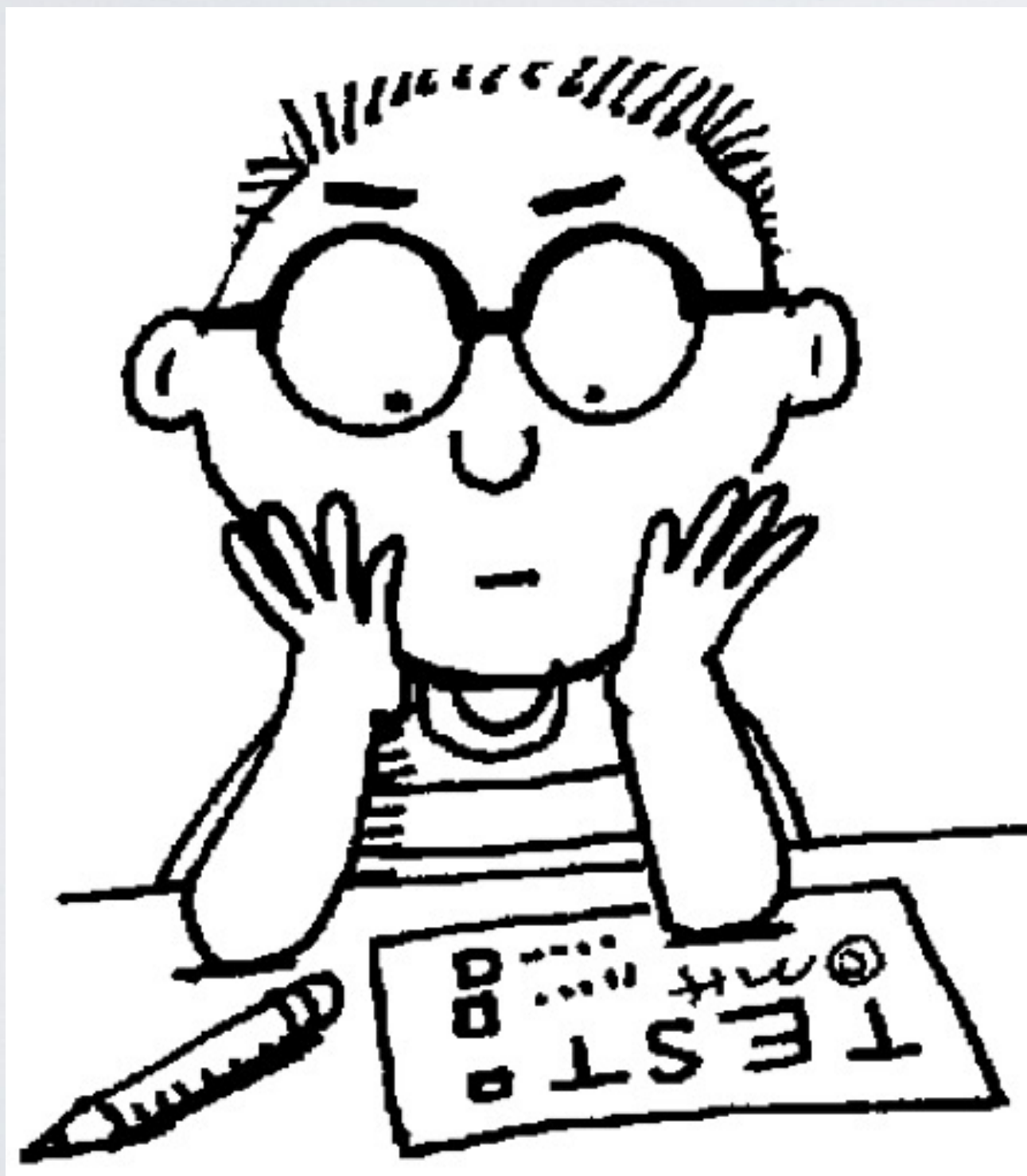
WELCOME TO **TOEFL**

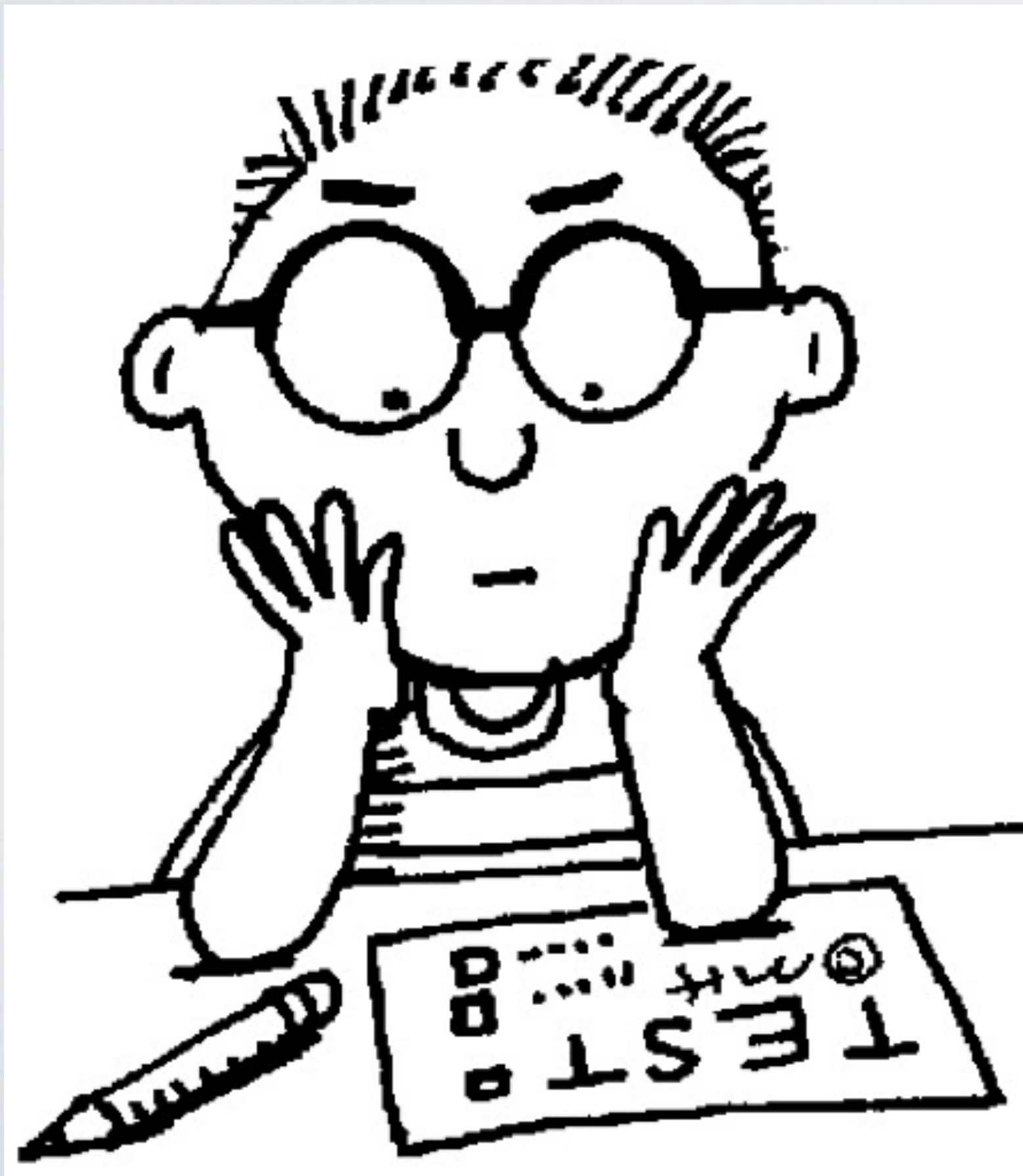

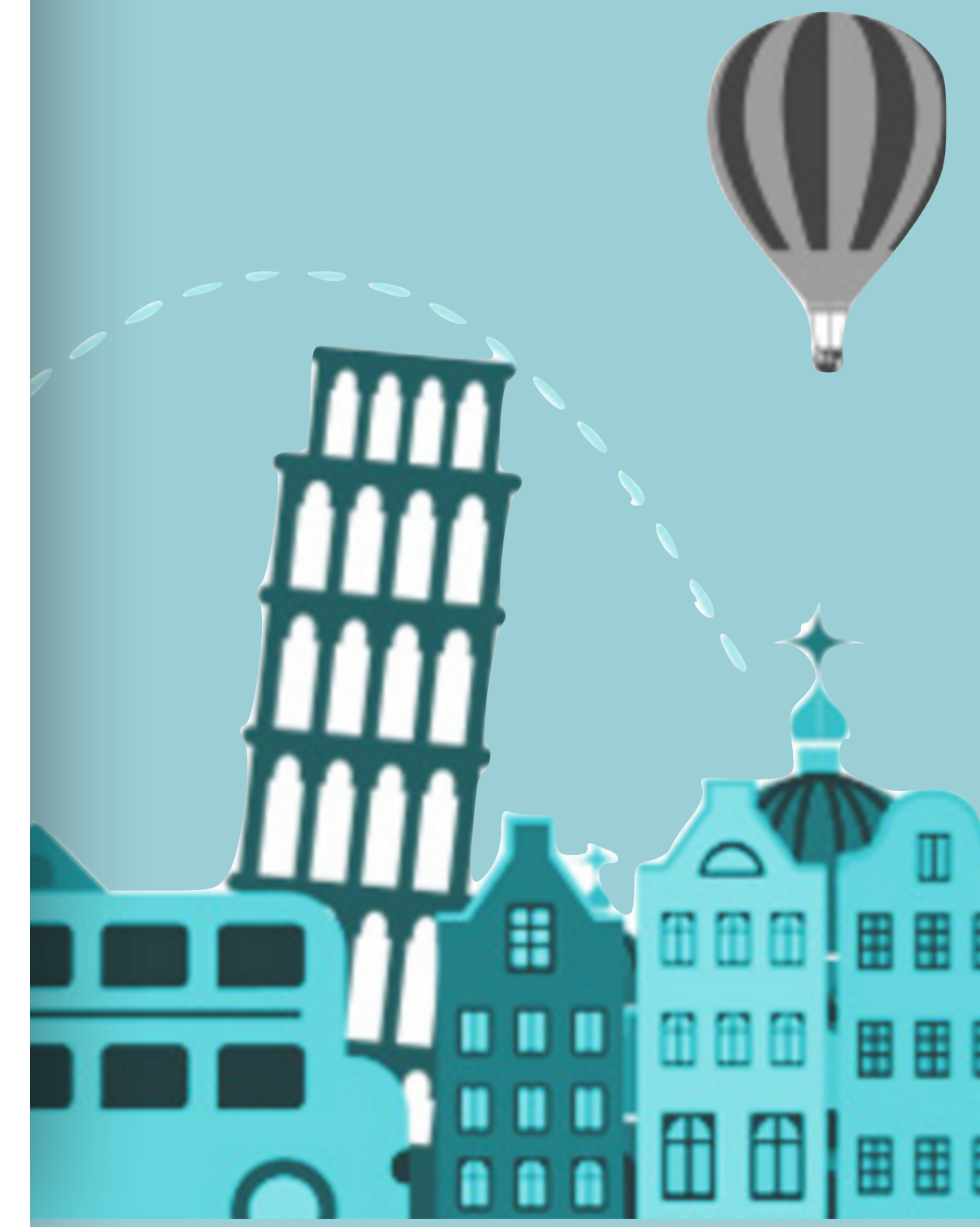
